Santander Asset Management (SAM) has appointed <u>Luis Yance</u> as head of Latin American investment strategies and Mexican equities.

Yance joins from Compass where he worked for 11 years as both portfolio manager for the firm's Mexican equities strategy as well as chief investment officer of its Mexican office.
